Dear Residents:

On Monday April 5, 2010, the Village will begin its Spring Clean-Up Program. The program will run for approximately three weeks and will end on Friday, April 30, 2010. After this date, streets will have one final pick up and will then be checked off as completed. Once completed, crews will not return for any reason.

In 2006 we began using biodegradable paper leaf bags, and will continue to use them into 2010. This product will sharply reduce labor costs associated with this program. Only leaves placed in biodegradable leaf bags will be picked up. The biodegradable leaf bags are the only acceptable bag to use and will be for sale (5 bags for \$2) in April at Village Hall.

The clean up will be for fallen winterkill branches and leaves only. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS! No pruning or brush from trees, shrubs or other material from clearing of property will be allowed.

Separate piles of bagged leaves only and twigs and branches should be placed at the roadside.
