- Attach a diagram, with exact dimensions of the grounds on which the display is to be held showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged, location of all buildings, highways and other lines of communications and overhead obstructions.
- Copy of the all license(s) of the person(s) in charge of firing, and setting up the fireworks along with their age, experience and physical characteristics. **(Please note that all personnel are required to wear fireworks company photo ID issued this year.)**
- Bond or indemnity insurance policy in the amount required by the Village of Southampton.
- Copies of permits and approvals attached from: **FAA, NYSDEC, USCG, USFWS**

CONDITIONS:

- The actual point at which the fireworks are to be fired shall be at least 200 feet from the nearest permanent building, public highway, railroad or other means of travel or otherwise specified by the Fire Marshal.
- No fireworks display shall be held during any windstorms in which the wind reaches a velocity of more than 20 MPH.
- Permits shall be submitted with **ALL** applicable documents no later than (30) days before the date of the display.
- The actual point at which the fireworks are to be fired shall be at least 50 feet from the nearest above ground utility lines, trees, or other overhead obstructions or otherwise specified by the Fire Marshal.
- The audience at such display shall be restrained behind lines in accordance with NFPA standard #1123 or otherwise specified by the Fire Marshal.
- The operator (the person in charge of setting up and firing the fireworks) shall be at least (21) years of age, and is responsible for ensuring that a sufficient number of assistants being the age of at least (18) years old, are on hand

for a safe conduct of a fireworks display. Only the operator and necessary assistants shall be permitted in the discharge area while the display is in progress.

- The operator of the fireworks is responsible for ensuring that all assistants are fully trained in the proper performance of their assigned tasks, and are aware of the hazards and wear all appropriate personal protective equipment and gear.
- There shall be at least two (2) persons, the operator and an assistant, constantly on duty during the discharge.
- The fireworks display must be terminated by 11:00 p.m.
- Arrangements for Fire department protection and personal to be present on site shall be made between the Fire Chief and the organization sponsoring said display. The fire Department personnel shall remain on duty until the termination of the display and all foreseeable hazards due to the fireworks display are remedied. Such arrangements shall be made prior to the Fire Chief's endorsement. Any cost for such services shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
- Arrangements for Police Department protection and personal to be present on site shall be made between the Police Chief and the organization sponsoring said display. The Police Department personnel shall remain on duty until the termination of the display and all foreseeable hazards due to the fireworks display are remedied. Such arrangements shall be made prior to the Police Chief's endorsement. Any cost for such services shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
- All fireworks that fire projectile shall be set up so that the projectile will go into the air as nearly as possible in a vertical direction, unless such fireworks are to be fired from a barge or from shore, when such fireworks shall be directed in such a manner that the falling residue from the deflagration will fall into such body of water.
- The operator, upon conclusion of the display, shall make a complete and thorough search for any unfired fireworks or pieces which have failed to fire or function and shall dispose of them in a safe manner. All debris from the discharged fireworks shall also be properly disposed of by the operator before leaving the premises. Such search shall be instituted at the earliest possible time following the conclusion of the display but in no event later than the first period of daylight which follows.
- The sponsor shall also be responsible for any other special provisions that the Fire Marshal deems necessary to the health, safety and welfare or the general public.
- Whenever the option of the Fire Marshal or the Operator, feel any adverse conditions exist that significantly affects safety, the fireworks display shall be postponed until the conditions are corrected.
- Permits must be approved by the Fire Marshal, Fire Chief, Police Chief, Fire Commissioner and or Mayor.
- ***This permit shall be revocable at any time for due cause by the Village Fire Marshal or his representative.***

The applicant hereby attests to the understanding of all rules and regulations governing public fireworks displays. In consideration of said permit, applicant does hereby consent and agree to comply with provisions of sections 405 and 270 of the NYS Penal Law, and NYS Fire Code chapter 33.
